EXPERIENCE

- During MCh pediatric surgery training performed variety of complex procedures independently like Tracheo-esophageal fistula repair, CDH repair, PSARP, Many urologic procedures like pyeloplasty, urethroplasties, hepatobiliary surgeries like CDC excision, MMC excision and VP shunt placement and innumerable pediatric surgical emergencies in 3 years.
- During post graduate program in General surgery, India, I got a lot of opportunities of performing surgical procedures independently like appendicectomies, Modified Graham's repair for duodenal perforations, resection and anastomosis, supra-pubic cystostomies, hernia mesh plasty, hydrocele operations, hemorrhoidectomies and have got a chance to assist in innumerable complex surgeries like Whipple's, abdomino-perineal resections, right hemicolectomies, choledochoduodenostomy, partial gastrectomies, open pyelonephrolithotomies, mastectomies, thyroidectomies as well assisted laparoscopic cholecystectomies and appendicectomies. I have performed around 20-25 upper GI Endoscopies independently on daily basis as a part of my residency curriculum. I was also involved in direct patient care both in wards and outdoor departments.
- I have been fortunate to have got an opportunity to work in three different hospitals in United States. The whole experience has been extremely fruitful as I got to know how American medical system works and it helped to equip myself to cater optimum and quality care.
 - Robert Wood Johnson hospital in New Jersey was my first assignment in Urology, where I attended the clinics and rounds and learnt the nuances of pathologies and surgical modalities for dealing urological ailments. I got opportunity to watch many office procedures like cystoscopies, stent removal, prostate biopsies, Uroflowmetry.
 - Around the same time I was offered the position of research assistant in Anesthesiology at Robertwood Johnson Hospital, in which I got involved in number of studies like Use of Facemask in deeply sedated patient to prevent the use of bag and mask during reversal, I actively collected data for the studies and was very enriching and wholesome experience.
 - During my term in General surgery at Mount Saini, Miami, I got a chance to work like a resident, which involved morning rounds, entering patient notes, case presentations and participating in medical boards and M & Ms, which enriched my clinical skills multi-fold along with understanding how American Medical system works. I got to watch umpteen surgeries during that month of rotation, like lumpectomy with sentinel node dissection, parotidectomy, bilateral adrenelectomy, many colorectal surgeries, laproscopic surgeries, gastric bypass.
 - Three month of rotation in surgery at Jackson Memorial Hospital, University Of Miami, has been by far the most rewarding experience I ever had. I witnessed plenty of surgeries, worked in cohesion with interns and residents and got the opportunity to be the active part in the patient care in a University hospital setting.



As a general practitioner in Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, Ministry of Health from 1/21/2005. I was posted in a primary health center cum ER cum obstetric center for 3&1/2yrs now.
