2	Embassy - NRI status Certificate of the Sponsorer
3	In case of Sponsorship, Sponsorship affidavit from the sponsorer should be <b>compulsorily legalized/notarized</b> and clearly stating the declaration for sponsoring the entire fees for the whole post graduate course.
4	Documents claiming that the sponsorer is an NRI (Passport, Visa of the sponsorer)
5	Relationship of NRI with the candidate as per the court orders of The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case W.P.(c) No. 689/2017- Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Ans. Vs Union of India & Ors. Dated 22-08- 2017
6	Citizenship of the candidate if holding OCI/PIO document
8	If the qualifying examination is other than that conducted in India, candidate should qualify NBE screening test and should have registered in National Medical Commission /Medical Council of India
9	If any other documents prescribed by MCC of DGHS

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** There will be verification of the NEET PG 2021 All India Rank submitted by the candidate with the information available in the NBE/MCC website. Such of those candidates whose NEET PG 2021 All India rank does not match with the information in the NBE/MCC website will be disqualified from the counseling process.

### **On the day of Counseling**

1. The physical presence of the candidate at the counseling is mandatory.
2. Only the candidate will be allowed into the campus & counseling hall. This is done in view of the COVID situation and the safety of all.
3. Candidate should sign the attendance register to mark their presence and time of reporting.
4. Candidates will be called on the basis of first come first serve basis for document verification. Successful candidates will be allotted seats according to first come first serve basis and number of seats available. Such candidates should produce their original documents for verification and pay the first-year fees at the time of counseling **HIMSR will not entertain any requests for extension in this regard.**
5. The option exercised by you with regard to selection of the course of study at the time of counseling will be final.
6. **Absence** of the candidate at the indicated reporting time and date will result in the **instantaneous forfeiture of any claim for a seat.**
7. The choice of course made by the candidate is final and binding and cannot be altered later under any circumstances

## **After Admission:**

1. Admission order/Provisional Admission Order and receipt/s for the payment made will be given to the candidate on completion of the admission process.
