




As the COVID-19 spikes calm, our vaccination center is actively participating in the national COVID-19 vaccination drive, providing free vaccination for people > 18 years of age.



The pharmacy is linked to the eprescriptions through the Hospital Information System for convenient and prescription free drug dispensing to OPD as well as IPD patients.
