### PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION:

The online counselling for admission will be done by Medical Counselling Committee of Directorate General of Health Services. Candidates are required to visit www.mcc.nic.in for details on Counselling Schedule and counselling scheme. They must read Notices posted from time to time and frequently asked questions displayed on the website of Medical Counselling Committee of DGHS, Govt. Of India. Institute will comply with orders from NMC & DGHS in all the matters related to admission and counselling.

#### **MEDICAL EXAMINATION:**

The Selected candidates have to undergo medical examination (Charges to be paid by the candidates) by a Medical Board setup by the HIMSR, consisting of faculty members of the Institute. If, in the assessment of the Medical Board a candidate is found medically unfit, the information will be shared with Medical Counseling Committee/ DGHS and decision of the Medical Counseling Committee/ DGHS in this regard shall be final.
