**Responsibilities & Duties of Core Committee members:**

**1. Training/Teaching of NTEP amongst**

- a. Faculty members to ensure cooperation and internal referrals of all chest symptomatic to be diagnosed and treated as per NTEP guidelines.
- b. Residents and interns should also be trained about NTEP guidelines.
- c. Undergraduates and post graduates to be trained with NTEP guidance so that they are able to diagnose and treat TB patients as per DOTS.
- d. Paramedical staff (Lab Technicians & Nursing staff) should be sensitized about any recent updates.
- e. Conducting sensitization workshops/CMEs for Medical colleges/Private sector including private practitioners, NGOs and other stakeholders.


## 2. Engagement with the NTEP

- a. Establish Microscopy and DOT centre in the medical college and health centers attached to the Dept. of Community Medicine.
- b. Health education to patients visiting the medical college hospital and the health Centres.
- c. Involvement in quality assurance network through the Microbiology department of Medical College.
- d. Accreditations of mycobacteriology Laboratory of Microbiology Department for culture and drug sensitivity testing under NTEP

## 3. Operational Research

Operational research should be directed on a priority basis, towards the broader objectives:-

- a. To increase case detection of smear positive cases.
- b. To improve DOT services to make it more patient friendly and ensure that treatment is directly observed.
- c. To undertake appropriate research studies with the ultimate objective of having consensus guidelines for diagnosis and management of childhood TB and extra-pulmonary forms of TB.
- d. To undertake studies on Multi-Drug Resistance-Profile and treatment outcomes of admitted patients and diagnosis and management of HIV/TB co infection.
