



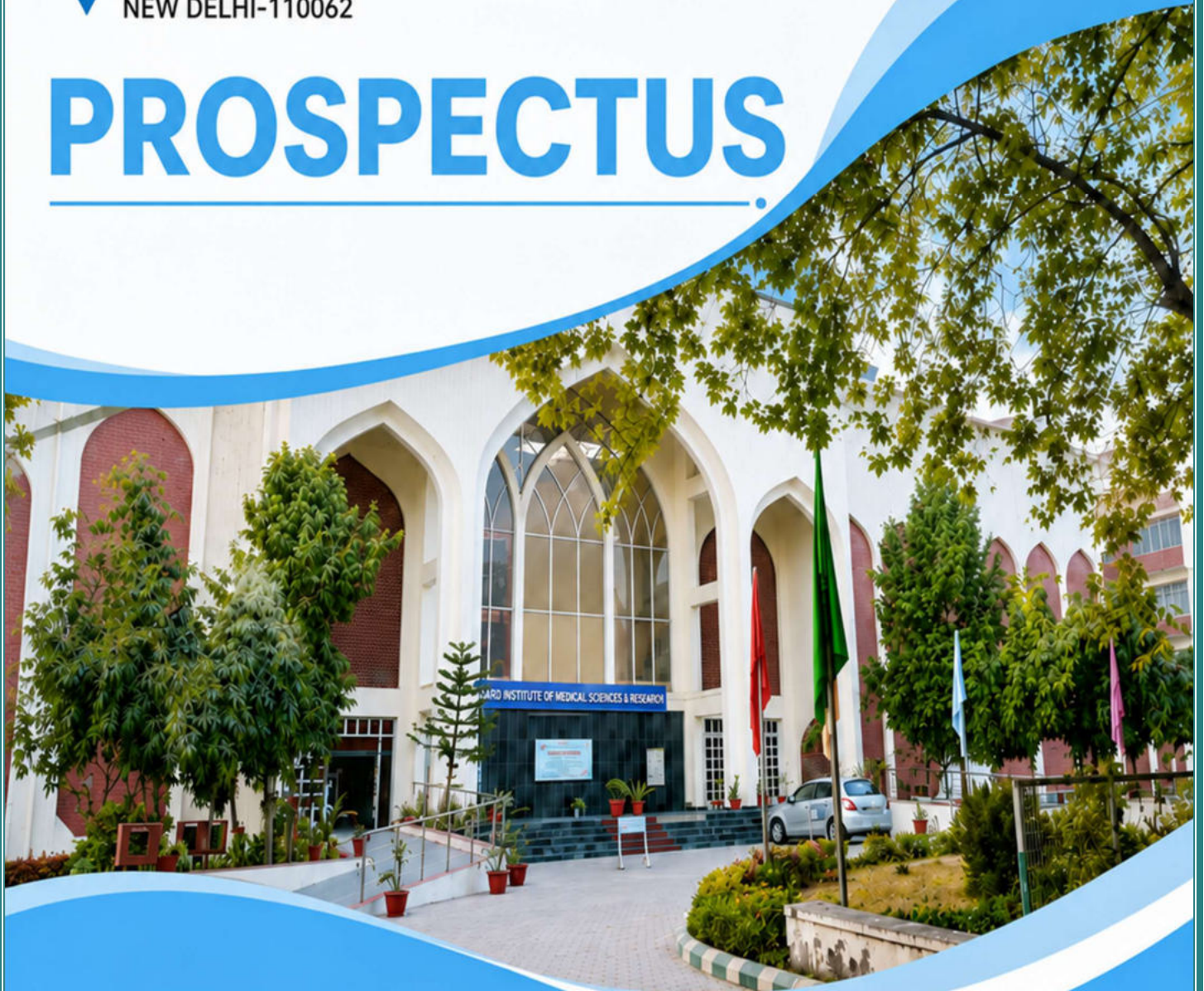

Programs of Study, Eligibility and Selection Process

Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery (MBBS)

DURATION OF STUDY

Each student shall undergo a period of study extending over **4½ (Four & a half)** academic Years followed by **1 (one) year** compulsory rotating Internship.

Number of seats: 150

50% (Fifty Percent) reservation for Muslim Minority by Birth candidates.

Note- There is no management Quota/Seats in Hamdard Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, all seats (100%) are pooled in All India Quota (AIQ) for Deemed to be Universities and are allotted by NEET-UG Counseling on the basis of merit by Medical Counseling Committee (MCC) of DGHS, GOI for **MBBS**. Institute has no role in counseling and allotment of any seat.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ALL THE CANDIDATES

- 1. Eligibility Conditions:** As per NEET- UG- 2026
- 2. Age Limit:** As per NEET- UG- 2026
- 3. Qualifying Examination:** As per NEET- UG- 2026

PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION:

As per Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) of Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), GOI, NEET UG- 2026 merit list of respective categories.

MEDICAL EXAMINATION :

The Selected candidates have to undergo medical examination (Charges to be paid by the candidates) by a Medical Board setup by the HIMSR, consisting of faculty members of the Institute. If, in the assessment of the Medical Board a candidate is found medically unfit, the information will be shared with Medical Counseling Committee/ DGHS and decision of the Medical Counseling Committee/ DGHS in this regard shall be final.

RAGGING:

- (A) Ragging is a serious offence that is totally prohibited in HIMSR & HAHC Hospital.
- (B) Anyone found guilty of ragging or abetting ragging, whether actively or passively, or being a part of a conspiracy to promote ragging, is liable to be punished in accordance with regulations of National Medical Commission (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Medical Colleges and Institutions) Regulations, 2021 as well as under the provisions of any penal law for the time being in force.

Hostel Rules and Regulations

These rules apply to all approved residents of the Freshers' Girls Hostel, HIMSR Hostel at Adchini including UG and PG students and other occupants approved by the Competent Authority.

1. Eligibility and Allotment

- Hostel accommodation is a privilege, is subject to availability and approval, and does not confer any permanent right of residence.
- Allotment shall ordinarily be valid for one academic year or the approved tenure,

whichever is applicable.

- Renewal or re-allotment shall depend on discipline, attendance, payment of dues, room availability and institutional requirements.
- The requested hostel or room category is not guaranteed. The Hostel Administration may allot, re-allot, shift or cancel a room in the interest of administration or discipline.
- Rooms shall not be exchanged, transferred, shared with an unauthorized person or occupied without written permission.

2. Hostel Fees and Other Charges

- Annual hostel charges shall be paid in advance for the full allotment period. Monthly charges shall be paid within the due date notified by the Hostel Administration.
- Monthly hostel and electricity charges shall be automatically deducted from the salary of the concerned residents, wherever applicable.
- Mess and laundry services are mandatory for UG and PG residents, unless a written exemption is granted by the Competent Authority.
- All UG and PG residents shall deposit a refundable Hostel Security Deposit of ₹10,000 at the time of allotment.
- The security deposit shall be refunded after vacation of the room, adjustment of outstanding dues and damages, and completion of the No-Dues process.
- The security deposit may be forfeited if a resident overstays for more than one month after completion of the course, tenure or last examination, as applicable.
- Late payment may attract a penalty and may result in suspension or cancellation of hostel allotment after due notice.
- All charges may be revised by the Competent Authority from time to time. Residents shall pay the revised charges from the date specified in the notification.

3. Attendance and Re-allotment

- Double-seater rooms for eligible UG residents may be allotted or re-allotted annually on the basis of academic attendance and other institutional criteria.
- Where eligible residents have equal attendance, allotment may be decided through a transparent draw conducted by the Hostel Administration.
- A decline in attendance, disciplinary violations or non-payment of dues may affect renewal or continuation of allotment.
- Vacant rooms shall be allotted only against approved applications.

4. Identity, Entry, Leave and Night-Out

- Residents shall carry their institutional identity cards and produce them when required by the Hostel Administration or Security.
- Entry and exit shall be recorded through the prescribed register or attendance system.
- UG residents shall ordinarily enter the hostel by 09:30 PM. late entry requires prior permission of the Warden.
- Quiet hours shall be observed after 10:30 PM.

- Overnight absence requires prior permission and an entry in the night-out booklet, including destination, contact details and expected return time.

5. Visitors

- Visitors are permitted only during notified visiting hours and in the designated visitor area.
- Visitors shall not enter residents' rooms or stay overnight without prior written approval.
- Residents are responsible for the conduct of their visitors.
- Unauthorized entry into the hostel is strictly prohibited.

6. Room Maintenance and Inspection

- Residents shall keep their rooms and allotted furniture clean and in good condition.
- Damage, loss or unauthorized alteration of hostel property shall be recovered from the responsible resident.
- Periodic room inspections may be conducted by authorized hostel officials.
- Residents shall promptly report maintenance, electrical, plumbing, sanitation or safety concerns.
- the No-Dues Certificate shall be issued only after verification of the room, fixtures and furniture.

7. Electrical Appliances and Fire Safety

- Electric heaters, induction cookers, immersion rods, hot plates, gas stoves or cylinders, air conditioners, refrigerators, washing machines, and other cooking, electrical or high-power appliances are strictly prohibited.
- Unauthorized appliances may be seized and kept in the Warden's office, and further action may be taken under hostel rules.
- Tampering with electrical fittings, CCTV systems, alarms or fire-safety equipment is prohibited.
- Emergency exits, corridors, staircases and fire-fighting equipment shall remain unobstructed.

8. Cleanliness and Waste

- Residents shall maintain cleanliness in rooms, bathrooms, corridors and common areas.
- Waste shall be segregated and disposed of only in designated bins.
- Defacing walls, furniture or hostel property is prohibited.

9. Mess and Food Rules

- Meals shall be served only during notified timings and shall ordinarily be consumed in the dining hall.

- Taking food from the dining hall to hostel rooms is prohibited unless specifically permitted on medical or other approved grounds.
- A penalty of ₹1,000 may be imposed for taking food to rooms in violation of hostel instructions.
- Repeated violations, or misconduct with the staff or security personnel monitoring compliance, may lead to written warnings and cancellation of hostel accommodation after three warnings.
- Residents shall maintain discipline and hygiene in the dining hall and avoid wastage of food.

10. General Conduct and Discipline

- Residents shall maintain discipline, dignity and decorum and treat fellow residents, staff and visitors respectfully.
- Ragging, bullying, harassment, discrimination, violence, intimidation or abusive behaviour is strictly prohibited.
- Residents shall not create nuisance, disturb others or organize unauthorized gatherings or parties.
- Residents shall comply with lawful directions issued by the Warden, Hostel Administration and Competent Authority.

11. Prohibited Activities

- Possession or consumption of alcohol, narcotic drugs, intoxicants, tobacco products or vaping devices.
- Smoking, gambling, cooking inside rooms, keeping pets or possessing weapons, explosives or hazardous materials.
- Theft, damage to property, unauthorized occupation, subletting or permitting an unauthorized person to stay.
- Possession, circulation or display of unlawful or objectionable material.

12. Internet and IT Usage

- Hostel internet shall be used only for lawful academic and personal purposes.
- Hacking, illegal downloading, misuse of the institutional network or sharing Wi-Fi credentials without authorization is prohibited.

13. Medical Emergencies and Communicable Diseases

- Illness, injury or a medical emergency shall be reported promptly to the Warden and the Institute Hospital.
- Residents shall comply with medical advice regarding isolation, temporary relocation or other precautions for communicable diseases.

14. Safety, Security and CCTV

- Theft, fire, accidents, suspicious activity and security concerns shall be reported immediately.
- CCTV monitoring may be used at entrances, dining hall and designated common or visitor areas for security purposes.
- Residents shall cooperate with authorized security checks and shall not obstruct security personnel in the discharge of duty.

15. Complaints and Grievances

- Complaints relating to hostel facilities, mess, laundry, safety or conduct shall be submitted through the prescribed register, email or grievance mechanism.
- A resident dissatisfied with the decision of the Warden or Hostel Committee may appeal to the Competent Authority.

16. Recovery, Damages and No-Dues

- Residents are liable for hostel fees, mess and laundry charges, applicable electricity or service charges, penalties, damages and other notified dues.
- The cost of damage or loss may be recovered from the responsible resident or jointly from occupants where individual responsibility cannot reasonably be determined.
- A No-Dues Certificate is mandatory before vacating or at completion or discontinuation of the course, posting or tenure.

17. Vacating and Unauthorized Stay

- Residents shall vacate within the period notified on completion of the course or tenure, cancellation or expiry of allotment, or when directed by the Competent Authority.
- Rooms, keys, furniture and other hostel property shall be handed over in good condition.
- Unauthorized occupation after the vacation deadline may attract a charge of ₹100 per day or such revised amount as notified.
- Overstay beyond one month may result in forfeiture of the Hostel Security Deposit in addition to recovery of applicable dues.

18. Disciplinary Action

Depending on the nature and repetition of the violation, action may include:

- Verbal or written warning, monetary penalty, recovery of damages, seizure of prohibited articles, suspension from the hostel or cancellation of accommodation.
- Serious misconduct may be referred to the Competent Authority for action under the applicable institutional rules and law.

19. Interpretation and Amendment

- The Dean/Principal or Competent Authority may interpret, amend or relax these rules in the interest of safety, discipline and administration.
- Any revision of fees, charges, timings, allotment criteria or hostel rules shall be communicated through an official notification and shall apply from the date specified therein.

20. Resident's Undertaking

- Every resident shall submit the prescribed hostel allotment form and undertaking confirming that the information provided is correct and that the resident agrees to comply with these rules and the Student Handbook (Rules and Regulations for Students), HIMSR.
